2nd of December


Collectors` Fair - Suceava

At the House of Culture in Suceava, stamp and coin collectors will have the chance to admire, exhibit and talk about their beloved collections, assembled over a significant number of years. The event takes place every Saturday, from 9 o'clock in the morning.

6th of December

Celebration of Saint Nicholas – Probota

The church of Probota was built in 1530 by Petru Rares. Its architecture is remarkable, being representative for 16th century Moldavia. Since 1993, this church is a part of the UNESCO world heritage.

Memory Jukebox – Suceava`s History Museum

This exhibition holds items such as a photo album of Alexandru Ioan Cuza, a jewelry box, a scarf given to Elena Negri by Vasile Alecsandri, music boxes, gramophones, records and old photos. The music accompanying this exhibition will also be reminding the public of the old times.

STUD-FEST – Suceava
