



Agenda of cultural tourist and traditional events in **Bucovina**

Spring in Bucovina is celebrated throughout the whole county: numerous events take place in March, such as concerts, exhibitions, contests, and theme-festivals.

Thus, at the beginning of the month, on the 2nd of March, everybody's invited to the **"Musical Journey at the Gates of Europe"** – a concert which aims to bring forward traces of the European Medieval culture. The show will feature creations from a wide range of musical periods, aiming to describe the Middle Ages as colorful, happy and even flamboyant.

On the 9th of March, the people of **Milisauti** commemorate the passing of **100 years since the world-famous writer Mircea Eliade was born**. Book and documents exhibitions, sittings and literary workshops are organized.



On the same day, people throughout the country commemorate the day in which **the 40 saints of Sevastia** were murdered for refusing to give up on their Christian faith. On this day, housewives of Bucovina prepare a special sweet, called "mucenici".

Later on, on the 11th of March, traditions are brought back on the first place, through the **"Treasures of the Romanian Soul" Festival**, an event already at its fifth edition. During this festival, people try to show their love and commitment towards their long lasting customs.

But the people in Bucovina not only care for their traditions and for their holidays, but also for their music. The 25th of March is entirely dedicated to the **"Buna Vestire" Religious Music Festival** - an event taking place for the 17th year in a row. Chorus recitals and folk art exhibitions are organized.

Regarding exhibitions, March is also booked with events. From the 23rd of February to the 23rd of March, the **Museum of Natural Science** hosts an exhibition called **"Fascination of the Crystals"** – giving visitors a chance to admire all sorts of rare and interesting crystals, to find out more about their origins and to purchase precious and semiprecious stones.



And, **until the end of the month**, those who are passionate about painting will have the chance to visit the **"Colors of Bucovina"** exhibition, signed by **Claudia Felicitas Zachmann**.
