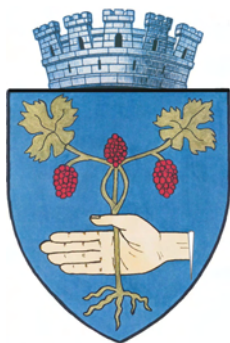
Artmania Festival
